Postgraduate Department Calendar 2023-24

<u>September</u>

Postgraduate Introductory Groups

All students will attend a post-graduate department introductory session, separated by grade level. These groups will provide students with an overview of the department and an introduction to post-secondary planning based on grade level. Students will complete a post-secondary planning survey and be given the opportunity to sign up for events, speakers, and groups held by the department throughout the year.

October

Four-year College Group

Seniors applying to 4-year colleges are invited to participate in a weekly group to explore the college application process and topics related to attending a 4-year college. Topics will include essay writing, completing the Common Application, applying for scholarships, dorm living, choosing a major, paying for college, time management, and other topics of choice.

Senior Parent/Student Conferences

Parent/student postgraduate planning meetings will be available for parents of seniors interested in meeting individually with Ms. Del Papa. A sign-up genius will be sent to all senior parents.

Community College Information Session

Ms. Donna Cuddy of Brookdale Community College will provide information on applying to a community college, the difference between a 2-year and 4-year school, and the transfer process from community college to a 4-year program.

Financial Aid Presentation for Seniors

All seniors are invited to attend an informational workshop on financial aid options for postsecondary education. Mr. Kimber Decker from the Higher Education Student Assistance Authority (HESAA) will provide an overview of the financial aid process and answer questions about grants, scholarships, and loans offered by the State of New Jersey.

Two- year College Group

Seniors applying to community colleges are invited to participate in a weekly group to discuss the process of applying to a community college and what to expect when transitioning from high school to college. Topics will include the application and placement requirements, financial aid, time management, support services, and other topics of interest to the students.

College Readiness Program- Brookdale Community College

A representative from Brookdale Community College will speak about Brookdale's free, college readiness courses.

December

Innovate Salon Academy Tour

Students interested in pursuing a career in cosmetology will tour a cosmetology school and learn about the training/licensing process.

January 2024

NJ Division of Vocational Rehabilitation Services- Jan 10

Practice Accuplacer/ College Placement Test- Jan 30

Students attending community college may be required to take a placement test prior to registration; the practice test will give students an opportunity to see what the test is like and to provide a basis for preparing for the test at the college.

February

Parent/Student Workshop-Accessing Disability Services in College- (Zoom) 6:00 pm- Feb 7

This workshop will review accommodations and supports available at the college level. The difference between college and high school supports will be discussed, as well as the process of applying for accommodations in college.

March

College Prep Group for Juniors

Juniors planning on applying to college are invited to attend a college planning group to explore the college application process and begin college planning. Topics will include how to begin a college search, what is needed to prepare for the college application, financial aid, essay writing, and more.

SAT Administration for Juniors- March 5

School-Day SAT testing will be administered to interested juniors. Students must register for the SAT by the application deadline.

ACT Administration for Juniors- March 26

School-Day ACT testing will be administered to interested juniors. Students must register for the ACT by the application deadline.

Brookdale Community College Placement Test Administration

Students planning to attend Brookdale Community College will have the opportunity to take the required placement test at Collier. Students needing to take placement tests for other community colleges can see Ms. Del Papa for help with making arrangements.

Parent/Student Workshop- The College Planning Process (Zoom) 6:00 pm

This workshop is geared towards juniors and sophomores who want to learn more about the college application process. The workshop will cover 2-year vs 4-year colleges, components of the college application and admissions process, and the types of financial aid available to pay for school.

Parent/ Junior Postsecondary Planning Conferences
